1. Basic information

• you have "student" status, you have to collect ECTS credits by attending classes (few hours) and doing research: 60 ECTS credits per year

- every PhD students is member of a "curriculum" (track)
- teaching activities and assessment are organized per track

2. Activities

• research project: in concert with your supervisor ("tutor"), maybe a secondary supervisor (from abroad)

- submission deadline for your thesis: 1st November 2021
- teaching classes / ECTS credits for classes
- → first year: 8 ECTS credits PhD programme + 8 ECTS credits PhD school
- → second year: 8 ECTS credits PhD programme + 8 ECTS credits PhD school
- \rightarrow third year: 4 ECTS credits PhD programme + 4 ECTS credits PhD school
- N.B.: "crediti di didattica" (for lessons) vs. "crediti di ricerca" (everything else)

- classed organized on PhD school level in several areas
- \rightarrow language skills: English academic writing and presentation skills; Italian; all other language classes offered by the University Language Center (co-called "CLA")
- → computer skills/Digital Humanities
- \rightarrow statistics

 \rightarrow practical issues connected to research, such as grant writing, intellectual copyright issues, organization of conferences etc.

- → general culture: "lectiones magistrales"

- assessment/end-of-the-year tasks (for September)
- \rightarrow submit documentation of acquired ECTS credits
- \rightarrow submit report of everything you did during the year
- \rightarrow submit term paper (= assessment method for the classes)
- \rightarrow present your results in a talk in the end-of-the-year meeting of your PhD track
- $\rightarrow\,$ partecipate with abstract and poster at the PhD day
- periods abroad: to the extent that is necessary in order to reach your objectives

3. Money

Monthly scholarship

- + funding for 'ordinary' research activities (conference participation etc.): addionally 10% of the scholarship per year = approx. Euro 1300
- + increase of your monthly scholarship for (research) periods abroad
- + funding for 'extraordinary' research activities (usually connected to the research projekt → call for applications published by the PhD school (usually twice a year)

4. Italian

- University language center (CLA) offers Italian classes for all levels, even for absolute beginners
- → orientation meeting: 5 October, 10.00 at "Studio di Italiano", Vicolo Campofiore, 2

- \rightarrow Italian courses provide ECTS credits on PhD School level!

5. Bureaucracy

• authorization has to be requested for

 \rightarrow "missioni": conference partecipation, periods in researchs institutes, archives etc.

 \rightarrow work: authorized only if connected to the research activities up to a max. 150 h. per year (PhD is full-time activity!)

- → "missioni": submitted to secretary of PhD school (always e-copy to stefan.rabanus@univr.it):
 - \rightarrow authorization granted by the Coordinator (< 6 months) or by the PhD board (> 6 months);
 - \rightarrow authorization to access funding granted by the Director of the PhD school
- → work: submitted to secretary of PhD school (always e-copy to stefan.rabanus@univr.it):
 - \rightarrow authorization granted by the PhD board

• principle: request authorizations as soon as possible!
