Her main interest concerns the conception of development as the interface between biology and culture. Her research program focuses on cultural analyses of infants' early socialization contexts and their developmental consequences in diverse cultural environments.

Author of several monographs and hundreds of scientific articles on infancy and child development across cultures, she has been awarded the Nehru chair professorship at the MS University of Baroda, India, and the fellowship in residence of the Netherlands Institute of Advanced Sciences.
