


**DRURY LANE, BUILT IN 1674 BY ARCHITECT

KILLIGREW AND THE KING'S COMPANY OF PERFORMERS**




DUKE'S THEATRE,


A LONGITUDINAL SECTION THROUGH A PLAYHOUSE
